 - > If you have properly and fully completed this application, including your PEN I.D.#, and attached the \$25 application fee, you will not need to send any other documents. Your application will be processed, and you will be notified in writing if your application has been accepted.
- b) **High School Students who are applying for admission to Year 1 of a "limited enrolment" degree (Natural Resource Science, Tourism, Forestry, Engineering, Nursing, and Fine Arts) OR Year 1 of any Diploma, Certificate or Trades program:**
 - > This application is the first step in the process.
