› Who can Apply

Dual Admission is open to College of New Caledonia (CNC) students, new or returning, who wish to complete one of the following degrees at Thompson Rivers University in Kamloops.

- › Bachelor of Arts (B.A.)
- › Bachelor of Science (B.Sc.)
- › Bachelor of Business Administration (B.B.A.)

This process will guarantee students transfer from CNC to TRU in one of these three degree programs only, with registration priority based on completed credits, subject to meeting all conditions outlined in this process.

Students may apply for admission or transfer into any other degree or diploma program at TRU under the same rules and conditions as all other transfer students or program applicants. Dual admission privileges do not extend beyond these three degree programs.

› How to Apply

CNC students complete the CNC—TRU Application for Dual Admission form and submit it to the CNC Office of Admissions by the deadline date. No fee payment is required at this time.

It is the responsibility of CNC students to ensure the courses they register in at CNC are transferable to TRU, and that these courses are acceptable as credits in their program of choice. It is strongly recommended that students planning to continue at TRU meet with a CNC Academic Advisor to review their selected courses for transferability.

› Next Steps

To be eligible for transfer to TRU under this Dual Admission program, students must present a minimum 2.00 GPA and complete a minimum of 30 transferable credits at CNC.

TRU will invite eligible students to 'activate' their dual admissions after September 30 and January 31 each year, providing TRU with an official copy of their CNC transcript and a copy of current courses in progress.

In order to receive registration priority for the fall semester, based on credits completed, students must 'activate' their transfer no later than April 30. Students may activate their transfer at any time after this date, but could lose the advantage of an early registration date. Dual admission students receive registration priority based on credits completed — they are not classified as transfers.
