Hire a TRU Co-op Student

Thompson Rivers University's Co-operative Education Program links highly motivated students with employers in various fields. Co-op is a flexible, cost-effective partnership between employers, educators and students.

Our Co-op Coordinators assist organizations with finding the most suitable candidate for work terms starting in May, September, or January, for 4, 8 or 12 months. The TRU Co-op Program will post your position, organize and host multiple forms of interviews, assist with follow-up and offers of employment. There are no fees for these services.

Hire a TRU Student or Graduate

Campus Interviews

Campus interviews are a convenient and cost-effective way for employers to select and interview graduating students for full-time employment. TRU offers your organization interview rooms and access to motivated leaders of tomorrow. There is no charge for this service.

Resume Drops

If you would prefer to interview candidates in your own office, then the Resume Drop program is an excellent alternative to campus interviews. We will advertise your job opportunity to students via our website and allow students to submit their resumes to the Career Education Department. You will have the option to have resumes sent to you via email, fax or by hard copy. This will free you from organizing the collection of resumes. There is no charge to participate in this program.

Part-Time and Casual Jobs

The Career Education Department has access to a large student talent pool who are interested in helping you. Send an email to the Career Education Department at careereducation@tru.ca and we will post your opportunity to all students. Please include: Contact name, contact email address or phone #, hours you will need the student, what the job entails, and wage. (Wage can be negotiable if you are unsure.)

Students who are interested will then contact you directly.

Events

Job Fair

Gain access to thousands of TRU students and alumni, brimming with talent, skills and enthusiasm. Many employers have told us this is their premier recruiting event and they never miss it.

Typically, more than 70 employers participate in our Job Fair. These events are open to all students and are a platform for sharing information on careers and job opportunities and recruiting talented individuals. Participating employers have the added benefit of a virtual profile of their organizations on our web site along with advertising throughout the campus. Space at these fairs is always limited, and employers are strongly encouraged to register as early as possible.

Employer Info Sessions

Throughout the year the TRU Career Education Department hosts employer presentations. These are a great way for organizations to promote themselves and recruit students. Meeting with students in a closed group setting will enable you to get the message out that your organization is a viable employment option.

Promoting Your Organization

Organizations may elect to hold a presentation prior to their on-campus interviews. In these sessions, representatives speak about career paths within their organization and/or talk about the positions they are recruiting for on campus.
