

## Environmental Science and Natural Resource Science Fellowship Award

## Two awards are available to senior undergraduate or graduate students!

TRU invites applications for the Environmental Science and Natural Resource Science Fellowship Award. The Fellowship was generously created by an anonymous donor for the development of two awards; one for Environmental Sciences and one for Natural Resource Sciences.

Recipients — either senior undergraduate students or graduate students — will be selected based on their scholarly achievements, their commitment to research, and their demonstrated potential for future contributions to our understanding of the environment.

The award is designed as an investment in the education of two exceptional students annually. Students awarded the Fellowship will show a desire to pursue studies that support the health and biological diversity of British Columbia's fish, wildlife and habitats.

The Fellowship is a prestigious award with a value of \$7,500 for each recipient.

## Applications:

The Fellowship is awarded on a competitive basis and applications must include:

- 1. An outline of your academic career in either Environmental Science or Natural Resource Science, detailing:
- Areas of research interest (2 page maximum)
- Current areas of concentration (1 page maximum)
- Examples of research and field work
- Description of future education and/or career plans (1 page maximum)
- 2. A CV, highlighting volunteer and community service
- 3. A copy of all transcripts
- 4. A letter of support from a TRU faculty member

Applications bearing the subject line, **Science Fellowship**, must be submitted to the Research Office, <u>research@tru.ca</u>, by **4 p.m. on the deadline date.**
