

FOURTH YEAR ECONOMICS COURSES

FOURTH YEAR COURSES OFFER IN DEPTH COVERAGE OF AN AREA OF INTEREST TO ECONOMISTS, AS WELL AS OTHER PEOPLE INTERESTED IN HUMAN BEHAVIOUR. THE APPLIED STATISTICS COURSES (ECON 432 AND BUEC 433) HAVE THE INTRODUCTORY STATISTICS COURSES FOR PRE-REQUISITES. FOR ALL OTHER FOURTH YEAR COURSES, BECAUSE THEY MAKE USE OF SIMPLE ECONOMIC THEORY, THE PRE-REQUISITE FOR THESE COURSES IS TYPICALLY EITHER MANAGERIAL ECONOMICS (BUEC 204) OR AN INTERMEDIATE THEORY COURSE (ECON 290 OR ECON 295).

ECONOMICS MAJORS MUST TAKE AT LEAST TWO FOURTH YEAR COURSES TO GRADUATE. SOME MINORS MAY ALSO REQUIRE A PARTICULAR COURSE. FOR EVERYONE ELSE THEY ARE OPTIONAL (ELECTIVES).
