(1) English Requirements & LPI:

Students must achieve a 'B' grade (73% in BC). Students with less than 73% can still be admitted and commence university studies but must achieve Level 4 on the LPI test OR complete TRU English 0600 before registering in English 1100 (mandatory for degree students).

For Limited or Selective admission programs the English requirement must be met to be eligible for admission.

(2) Math Requirements:

Enriched Math courses (Math 2205, 3205, and 3207) are also acceptable.

Assessment Test:

This test measures competency and aids in proper student placement

UNIVERSITY PREPARATION:

Students who did not complete a high school course required for admission to a TRU program, or who want to upgrade their ability in specific courses (eg. Math or Science) can be admitted to the U-Prep Program, prior to applying for admission to another program. First-year university students may also take U-Prep courses if they need to complete or upgrade a required course. However, students should not consider this as an alternative to completing required courses in high school.

Summary of Admissions Processes

There are three different admissions processes at TRU. You need to know which process is in place for your program.

OPEN ADMISSION: Applications are accepted on a first-applied, first-admitted basis, if they meet (or are expected to meet, if currently in Grade 12) the admission requirements of the program.

LIMITED ADMISSION: Applications are accepted and admission is offered when all requirements have been met (or are expected to be met, if currently in Grade 12) until the limited number of seats in the program are full. Students not accepted may apply to 1st year university Arts, Science, Computing Science or Business as an alternative.

SELECTIVE ADMISSION: Applications are accepted up to a deadline date, then reviewed. Only a selected number will be offered admission, until all seats in the program are full. Students not accepted may apply to 1st year university Arts, Science, Computing Science or Business as an alternative.

ADVANCED REGISTRATION OPTION:

Grade 12 students entering Arts (BA), Science (BSc), Computing Science (BCS), and Business (BBA), will be offered an opportunity to advance their Registration Priority (their date to register and choose their courses) by providing their Grade 11 and interim Grade 12 transcript of marks. For Arts students, priority will be based on marks in English and three other academic subjects; for Business students, one of these three marks will be Math 2204 or 3204; for Science students these marks will be Math 2204 or 3204 and two Science courses.

GRADE 11 EARLY APPLICATION: Students in grade 11 can apply for EARLY admission for first year Bachelor of Arts, Business Administration, Computing Science, Natural Resource Science, Science and CSOM: Computer Systems Diploma between May 1, 2012-June 15, 2012.
