

SECOND YEAR ECONOMICS COURSES

THERE ARE TWO KINDS OF SECONDYEAR ECONOMICS AND BUSINESS ECONOMICS COURSES: THEORY COURSES AND APPLICATIONS COURSES.

THEORY COURSES: ECONOMICS THEORY COURSES INCLUDE BUEC 204 (MANAGERIAL ECONOMICS), ECON 290 (INTERMEDIATE MICROECONOMICS) AND ECON 295 (INTERMEDIATE MACROECONOMICS). THESE COURSES HAVE TWO SETS OF PREREQUISITES: ECONOMICS AND MATHEMATICS. ALL OF THESE COURSES REQUIRE ECON 190 AND ECON 195. BUEC 204 AND ECON 290 ALSO REQUIRE THE SUCCESSFUL COMPLETION OF MATH 117.

APPLICATIONS COURSES: APPLICATIONS COURSES IN ECONOMICS CAN COVER A WIDE VARIETY OF MATERIAL. THE APPLICATIONS COURSES WE OFFR AT SECOND YEAR INCLUDE TWO TYPES OF COURSES: (1) ECONOMICS AND BUSINESS STATISTICS (BUEC 232 AND 233), AND (2) BROAD APPLICATIONS: ECON 243 (ECONOMIC ISSUES), ECON 260 (THE BC ECONOMY) AND ECON 263 (ABORIGINAL ECONOMICS). THESE COURSES HAVE ONLY ONE ECONOMICS PREREQUISITE COURSE: BUEC 232 REQUIRES EITHER 190 OR 195. BUEC 233 REQUIRES BUEC 232. ALL OTHER SECOND YEAR COURSES REQUIRE EITHER 122 OR 190 OR 195.
