If you wish to participate as a presenter, please complete the Proposal Form available at www.tru.ca/rigs/ugc. All applicants must list a faculty supervisor/sponsor and include an abstract of the proposed presentation.

Selected full papers of the conference will be published in the Conference Proceedings, together with representations of posters and displays. The Proceedings are distributed within Canada, giving TRU students the privilege to document and showcase their work.

The Office of the Associate Vice President Research and Graduate Studies presents a number of awards to students whose work represents the best in visual, oral and written categories.

Conference proposals are due by January 28, 2011. Please submit an electronic copy of the completed proposal form with an Abstract (not to exceed 250 words) to truugc2011@gmail.com using “**Proposal**” as the subject line. Proposals will be adjudicated and presenters will be notified whether or not their proposal has been accepted by Feb. 25, 2011.
