- Biology 12, Chemistry 12 or Physics 12 or equivalent, C+ minimum grade, Biology 12 is recommended

- 80 hours orientation at a veterinary facility (working or volunteering or observing) (form)
- Three confidential reference forms (submitted directly from the referee), one from each of the following areas:
 - 1) Veterinarian orientation site
 - 2) Other animal related (non-vet related)
 - 3) Any non-animal work/volunteer experience
- Attendance at a program orientation session (upon invitation)

- 5. Submit all required supporting documents

Next Steps:

- 1. We will contact you within 2-3 weeks to let you know that we have received your application.
- 2. Use the check-list in this package to make sure you have included all the supporting documents required for the program you are applying to. For limited and selective programs, all documents must be submitted by the deadline in order for your application to be considered.
- 3. Once we have reviewed your application and supporting documents, we will notify you about the admission decision after the deadline.
- 4. If you are offered a seat in the program, you will have to pay a commitment fee to confirm your seat.
