GENERAL REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. 60 credits of first and second year courses that have university transfer credit at the 1000 level or higher at UBC, SFU, UVIC, or UNBC.
2. A cumulative GPA of 2.0 for all courses.
3. At least 30 of these 60 credits of course work must have been completed at TRU.
4. No courses will be used to meet more than one of the specific requirements.
5. A student must apply for the Associate Degree by submitting an application form to the Registrar's Office. Convocation ceremonies are held in June.

SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. 6 credits in first year English
2.
3. 36 credits in Arts, which shall include:
a) 6 credits in Social Sciences;
b) 6 credits in Humanities (other than English);
c) 24 credits of Arts, which must include 18 credits of second-year level in two or more subject areas:
4. 9 credits in Sciences:
a) 3 credits in Math or Statistics or Computing Science
b) 3 credits in a Lab Science (Biology/Chemistry/Physical Geography/Geology/Physics)
c) 3 additional credits in Science or Lab Science
5. 9 credits of first or second year courses: (these courses may be outside the Arts and Sciences)
