### ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS FOR ADMISSION TO BSW YEAR 3

- ◆ **60 credits of academic coursework acceptable to the BSW Program are required for admission (a minimum of 54 credits may be considered), with a minimum GPA of 2.33, and including:**

#### Required Courses:

- 3 credits of English Composition (TRU's ENGL 1100) or equivalent, or 6 credits of English Literature
- Social Work 2060 (Formerly Social Work 200A) or equivalent
- Social Work 2120 (Formerly Social Work 200B) or equivalent

#### Recommended Courses:

- PSYC 1110/1210, 2130/2230\*
- SOCI 1110/1210
- POLI 1110/1210
- PHIL 1110
- ARCH 1110; ANTH 1210/2140
- **Strongly recommended:** Additional academic English courses at any level

\*Note: Students will receive credit for **either** PSYC 2130 & 2230 **or** TRU-OL SOCW 3551

#### Admission to BSW third year requires the completion of:

- ◆ 1500 word Admission Statement (see the admissions package for full information)
- ◆ Supplementary Information Form indicating if student wishes to apply for Equity Admissions
- ◆ Transcript (interim transcript) at time of application; if any courses are still in progress at time of application, resubmit final transcripts once all grades have been posted

**Note:** The number of applicants to the BSW program exceeds the total number of available spaces; therefore, it is recommended that students have an alternative career goal planned, and choose their courses and electives to satisfy both programs.

- For example: a student who starts their post-secondary education in a Bachelor of Arts and plans to apply to the BSW program after completing a minimum 54 credits (60 recommended) should ensure their planning satisfies both the BA and BSW requirements.
