TRU Aboriginal Mentor Program Overview

The Aboriginal Mentor Program assists new students with a successful transition into Thompson Rivers University (TRU). Through training, the TRU Mentor Program develops mentors' skills and abilities for the work they do independently and collaboratively for the Students they mentor. Mentoring happens in different forms (One-to-one, groups, events, workshops, etc.) and based on student needs. It is supported by the Aboriginal Mentor Coordinator in Cplul'kw'ten ("The Gathering Place"-House 5).

Purpose: To provide support and mentoring to new Aboriginal Students attending Thompson Rivers University (Kamloops).

Eligibility: Must be at least 18 years of age and a self-identified Aboriginal Student attending part-time or full-time in the Fall and Winter semesters at TRU Kamloops.

Commitment: Minimum of 1 hour per week (meet face-to-face at least twice per month) September—April, some workshop sessions (1.5 hours each based on availability), and should attend Orientation activities.
