

APPLICATION DEADLINE **April 1, 2019**

20 awards valued at **\$3,000** each are available to students graduating from secondary schools within the TRU region* outside of Kamloops.

Awards are based on academic and community involvement and require a 70% overall average in Grade 11 or Grade 12. Students must be admitted to a degree, diploma, or 8-month ladderable certificate. Preference will be given to applicants who are the first person in their family to attend university (first generation student). Awards will be given out based on geographic location and by area of study.

TRU Entrance Awards are available to first time students who have not previously attended a college or university (other than having completed up to 12 transferable university credits on a part-time basis), and are Canadian citizens or Permanent Residents.

*The region will (approximately) be bordered by Hope – Lytton – Williams Lake – Valemount – Golden – Vernon, but excludes city of Kamloops secondary schools.

Submit a letter outlining your leadership and/or service record and accomplishments either in your secondary school or community. Areas of leadership or involvment can include student government, volunteer positions, community and religious organizations, sports and athletics, music and art, clubs, and any activity which has developed you as a person and has meaningfully impacted others. Your letter should also outline your educational goals.

- □ **Reference** Attach at least one letter of reference.
- □ **Transcript** Attach your current transcript (may be unofficial). The average of all my Grade 12 courses is_____%.`
