

TRU Entrance Scholarships › Application • 2010



Application Deadline › March 1, 2010

Successful applicants will have the value of their scholarship credited to their tuition account on a semesterized basis.

The following TRU Entrance Scholarships are available to first time students entering a program of two years or longer who have not previously attended a college or university (dual credit enrolment excluded), and are Canadian citizens or Permanent Residents (landed immigrants):

TRU Ambassador's Entrance Scholarship

Awards of \$12,000 each (*minimum of 8 awards*)
(\$3,000 per year, renewable over four years)

This scholarship recognizes exemplary leadership and community service, through documented references, combined with solid academic performance. Students offered this award also accept the responsibility of potentially representing the university at one or more activities during the academic year.

TRU President's Entrance Scholarship

Awards of \$3,000 each (*minimum of 25 awards*)

This scholarship recognizes academic excellence based on select Grade 11 academic courses.

TRU Leadership Scholarship

Awards of \$3,000 each (*minimum of 5 awards*)

This scholarship recognizes leadership, through documented references, combined with solid academic performance.

TRU Community Service Scholarship

Awards of \$1000 each (*minimum of 25 awards*)

This scholarship recognizes community service, through documented references, combined with solid academic performance.

PART II

TRU Ambassador's Entrance Scholarship

> Applicants for the Ambassador's Entrance Scholarship must submit a letter outlining their exemplary leadership and service record, as well as at least two letters of reference documenting their accomplishments. Include areas such as student government, volunteer positions, community and religious organizations, sports and athletics, music and art, clubs, and any activity which has developed your character, leadership abilities, goal orientation, and passion for learning. Your letter should also outline your educational goals.

PART III

TRU President's Entrance Scholarship

> This scholarship is based solely on marks. Although it is based on your top five academic Grade 11 courses, Grade 12 interim marks may be used to break ties.

PART IV

TRU Leadership Scholarship

> Applicants for the Leadership Scholarship must submit a letter outlining their leadership record, as well as at least one letter of reference. Include any area of involvement in which you played a clear leadership role, and describe the nature and duration of each involvement.

PART V

TRU Community Service Scholarship

> Applicants for the Community Service Scholarship must submit a letter outlining their record of service in any community (school, service club, church, civic, etc.) in which they have been involved, as well as at least one letter of reference documenting this service. Please describe the nature and duration of each involvement.

> Note: if applying for more than one scholarship, only one letter and set of references are required.

Please note that only successful applicants will be notified. All notifications will be sent by April 15 at the latest.
