JOB DESCRIPTION:

We are hiring university students to be Teacher Naturalists. You will plan and teach nature programs to children (ages 4-13), learn the various flora and fauna of the Cariboo-Chilcotin Region, care for the nature house live and static displays, and guide visitors at the nature centre. You will be working alongside two other Teacher Naturalists, affording you the opportunity to share, collaborate, and brainstorm together. Although you'll be responsible for developing and running your program, there will be support and guidance from year-round staff.
