


Q1 Tell us about yourself. Please select one of the following:






Q2 If you are a faculty member at TRU, please select one of the following:




Q3 If you work at TRU, for how many years have you been employed by TRU?




Q4 If you are a student, which describes you?




Q5 If you are a student, for how many years have you studied at TRU?






Question 6: How many TPCs attended




Q7: What motivated you to attend this year



Q11: Main Takeaways


- Lots of mentions about specific workshops
