Awards are available to full-time and part-time domestic students applying to the TRU Williams Lake Campus. The award applicant must:

- Be a student enrolled in any program at the Thompson Rivers University Williams Lake Campus. New and incoming students will be given priority, but all applications will be considered
- Have successfully completed grade 12, with a minimum academic average of 70% or better in two grade 12 semesters
- Be a Canadian Citizen or Permanent Resident

Please note: Award applicants who demonstrate a financial need will be given higher priority, and students who have received another TRU Entrance Scholarship are not eligible for these awards.

The award recipients will have the value of the award (ranging from \$500 - \$2000, as decided by the adjudication committee) credited to their account on a semesterized basis: half of the award will be applied as a tuition reduction at the start of classes in the Fall 2022 semester. The remaining amount will be applied as a tuition reduction for the Winter 2023 semester. Successful applicants will be presented with their award the first week of December 2022.
