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## Comments/Communication with Student

### Electives

When you are choosing a course to fulfill electives, 1000/2000 level courses are considered lower level and 3000/4000 level courses are considered upper level. Please make sure the courses chosen fits the elective level requirement needed for your degree. If you are not sure, contact your program advisor before registering.

### HLTH Courses

These are capstone courses that should be taken after all other LL and UL electives have been completed. RT Dual credential students cannot start these courses until, at least, they have completed a semester of program clinic education (after RESP 1590 or RESP 2600 completed). Ideally, the final HLTH course is completed while in clinical year. Currently HLTH course are only offered through TRU-OL. Do not register for any HLTH courses until your consult with your program advisor. HEAL 4021 is a prerequisite for HEAL 4011.

### Degree Requirements

120 credits, minimum 45 at the upper (3000 and 4000) level, with a minimum grade point average (GPA) of 2.0, are required.
