

GUIDELINES FOR BACHELOR OF SOCIAL WORK

Admission to the Bachelor of Social Work requires 54-60 completed credits of approved coursework with a minimum GPA of 2.33. While students with 54 credits may be considered, most applicants have a minimum of 60 credits. Students typically apply from the Bachelor of Arts or the Human Services Diploma. (Please speak to an Advisor for other laddering options and GPA requirements)
