

CHAIR LEADERSHIP AWARD

TERMS OF REFERENCE

The Provost and Vice-President Academic's Office is pleased to sponsor a Chair Leadership Award in recognition of the many contributions made by Chairs to their Department, Faculty / School and the TRU community. This award recognizes individuals who demonstrate outstanding leadership qualities and abilities in carrying out their full range of functions in their role as Chair.

Criteria

The award is given to those individuals who best display any or all of the following qualities:

- Have demonstrated innovative leadership in developing and implementing initiatives related to their role as Chair;
- Have enriched the life of their Department, Faculty / School either directly or indirectly for students, faculty, staff or the TRU community through their outstanding leadership;
- Have enhanced the reputation of their Department, Faculty or School and TRU through their leadership;
- Are highly regarded for integrity and professional conduct as leaders in their role as Chair.

Eligibility

Eligible nominees for the Chair Leadership Award shall be:

- Existing full-time Chairs who have completed at least one full three (3) year continuous term as Chair; or,
- Former Chairs who have completed at least one full three (3) year term as Chair within the past three (3) years.

Nomination & Selection Process

Nominations will be made by three (3) members of the Department where the nominee is Chair; or three (3) members of the existing Chairs group; or alternately, a combination of the Chair group and Department.

The selection of the Chair Leadership award will be made by a Committee of Deans representing the Faculty or School of each of the nominees and chaired by the Director of Human Resources or designate.

Award winners will receive an engraved plaque plus an opportunity to attend a Leadership workshop / conference to a maximum of \$1,500 and approved by the Provost's Office.
