On Campus:

Starbucks can be found in Old Main (see map below)...South-East of the site of the conference.

More substantial eateries can be found south of the campus.

Fox and Hound Pub, Bold Pizzeria – East on summit, turn right past Esso station uphill to the mall. Bold is at the front, Fox and Hound at the back

Noble Pig, Red Collar – Craft Brewery (Red collar has limited food)

Mitz's Kitchen, various hotels, pizza joints on Victoria Street


Connecting to Eduroam – Android

1. Before you can connect to Eduroam you will need to download the certificate installer from the Eduroam website.


If you are not already connected to the internet, connect to the TRU network.

After clicking connect a sign in page will appear and you can sign in using your TRU username and password.


2. After you have connected to the internet go to the play store and download the GetEduroam app.



3. Open the app after it finishes installing and search for Thompson Rivers University. Select TRU from the list of institutions and be sure to choose “TRU Staff” as your profile, press next.




4. Enter your TRU email and password and press “Connect to Network”.



Connecting to Eduroam – iOS

1. Before you can connect to Eduroam you will need to download the certificate installer from the Eduroam website.



After clicking connect a sign in page will appear and you can sign in using your TRU username and password.


2. After you have connected to the internet go to the app store and download the GetEduroam app.






4. Enter your TRU email and password and press "Connect to Network".



5. You will now be asked to allow the app to join your phone to the Eduroam network. Press allow on both prompts.



6. You will get the screen to the right and you are now connected to Eduroam.

6. Once the installer has finished downloading, run it. You will see the screen to the right asking if you want to install Eduroam, select Continue.


8. Enter your TRU email and password when you are prompted for your credentials.

9. You will be prompted to log in with your computer password to allow the install. Enter your computer password and press OK.



10. After the installation process is finished you will see the screen to the right showing that the certificates have been installed and you will be connected to the Eduroam network.


