

Placement TESTS

ESL | English | Math

Students taking the test must register at least one day prior to the test date.

Register at: TRU World (3rd floor, International Building)

- If you have already submitted a language proficiency test, you are **not** required to write the EPT (English Placement Test). See details on the back of this page.
- Alternative language proficiency tests will not be accepted **after** writing the EPT. Students will be placed in the appropriate level based on the EPT results.
- Testing takes place in a computer lab in the Old Main building. The exact room number will be posted on the day of the test.
- Students are to report to the testing room at 8:45 am on the testing day. Bring a picture ID and student number.

Am I required to write the EPT test?

If you have submitted a language proficiency test, you are not required to write the TRU EPT language test.

EPT testing priority will be given to students with no external scores or if the external scores have significant variance in band scores (greater than a 1.0 variance). Students with successful and consistent external scores will not be provided further testing.

Consistent IELTS scores examples:

- Overall score of 6.0, no band less than 5.0 or higher than 7.0 - Not eligible for EPT.*
- Overall score of 5.5, no band less than 4.5 or higher than 6.5 - Not eligible for EPT.*

Significant variance example:

- Overall score of 6.0 with bands lower than 5.0 or higher than 7.0 - Eligible (but not required) to write EPT.*
- Overall score of 5.5 with bands lower than 4.5 or higher than 6.5 - Eligible (but not required) to write EPT.*
