



FORESTRY TRANSFER PROGRAM PROGRAM INFORMATION PACKAGE

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

TRU offers a [Forestry Transfer program](#) to the Faculty of Forestry degree programs at UBC. The first general year of Forestry and the first and second years of Forest Resource Management, Forest Operations, Forest Science, and Natural Resource Conservation.

The Faculty of Forestry at UBC offers four-year degree programs of undergraduate study in five areas of forestry: Forest Resources Management, Forest Operations, Forest Science, Wood Science and Industry, and Natural Resource Conservation.

The first two years are designed to prepare students for entry into the profession of forestry and the last two years for careers in a specialized field.

Students who have completed the required first or second year courses with a Grade Point Average of at least 2.50 are eligible to apply for admission to the UBC Faculty of Forestry. The GPA is calculated over all attempts (including failures) in all courses. Admission to the Faculty of Forestry may be competitive and chances of acceptance increase with GPA standing.

Fall (September to December)

Winter (January to April)

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Grade 12 (or equivalent) or [mature student status](#)
- English Studies 12/English First Peoples 12 with a minimum of B (or [equivalent](#))
- Pre-calculus 12 with a minimum C+ (or [equivalent](#))
- Two of: Life Sciences 11 (formerly Biology 11), Chemistry 11, or Physics 11 (all three strongly recommended) (or [equivalent](#))
- One of: Anatomy & Physiology 12, Chemistry 12 or Physics 12 (or [equivalent](#))

Please note: Life Sciences 11 is the minimum requirement for entry into Biology 1110 at TRU.

HOW TO APPLY

2. [Submit official transcript\(s\)](#) to Enrolment Services

Official High School Transcripts:

BC high school applicants must register to release their transcript to TRU through the [Student Transcript Service \(STS\)](#). For assistance with this process, please refer to the Transcript Service help videos or connect with our Future Students team at 250-828-5006. Out of province applicants must send their official transcripts now and at the time of graduation. Please visit your provincial or territorial Ministry of Education for further information on how to order.

Official Post-Secondary Transcripts:

Applicants are required to submit official transcripts from all post-secondary institutions attended. If you are currently attending another post-secondary institution, you must submit an official transcript at the time of your application. Should you have courses in progress, you will be required to submit a final official transcript at completion. You are not required to submit your TRU transcript.
