Who Can Apply?

- What results were obtained?
- What is the significance of your findings?

Rules & Guidelines

- A single static PowerPoint slide is required. Images used in the slide must be your own, or you must have permission from the owner of the photo(s) and provide proper credit (literature references should be cited using a recognized citation style).
- 2. No additional electronic media is permitted (e.g., sound, video files).
- 3. Can include additional props (e.g., costumes, lab equipment)
- 4. Presentations are limited to 3 minutes maximum.
- 5. Presentations that go over 3 minutes will be disqualified.
- 6. Presentations can be spoken, or in the form of a poem, rap, song ...
- 7. Presentations must be based on original student research (presenting someone else's work will not be accepted).
 - a. Research done as part of a course project will be considered, however, preference will be given to students who conducted their own original research (i.e., UREAP, USRA, Directed Studies, Research Assistant, Research Apprentice, Community Engaged Research Fellow, Knowledge Makers, Honours Thesis)
- 8. The decision of the adjudicating panel is final.
