#### First-Time Login

- 1. Navigate to Password Reset Portal (myid.tru.ca)
- 2. Username: Your TRU Student ID.
- 3. Temporary Password: "TRU" + your birthdate (ddmmmyy). Example: if born on September 3, 1991, password is TRU03sep91.
- 4. Select MYTRU in the dropdown menu.
- Create New Password: Use your temporary password as old password. Create a new one with at least 8 characters, mix of upper and lower case letters, and numbers. Avoid using your name, TRU ID, phone number, or birthdate.

## **CAMPUS SERVICES**

## MEDICAL INSURANCE

#### MEDICAL INSURANCE IS MANDATORY IN CANADA AT ALL TIMES

TRU automatically enrols all new students into guard.me insurance for their first 90 days in Canada.

Exchange students must complete the opt-out form on the **guard.me/tru** website and upload their insurance in English immediately.



#### MEDICAL SERVICES PLAN

Three months after entering British Columbia, students are eligible to enrol in the BC Medical Services Plan (MSP).

Under the Medicare Protection Act, enrolment with the Medical Services Plan (MSP) is mandatory for all eligible residents and their dependents. Our ISAs will help you complete an application for MSP insurance during orientation.

# EXTENDED HEALTH AND DENTAL INSURANCE THROUGH TRU STUDENT UNION

Full-time Fall semester students are automatically enrolled into TRUSU's Health and Dental Plan Coverage.

The following students must opt in to TRUSU's Health and Dental Plan coverage:

- · Winter semester students
- Summer semester students
- · Exchange/Study abroad students
- · Students who previously opted out
- Dependents of the above

If you opt in to the TRUSU Health and Dental Plan, you are NOT automatically enrolled every year and will need to opt in again the following year to maintain your coverage.


