

Pre-Dental Hygiene Diploma

Applicants to the Dental Hygiene Diploma Programs must complete one full year of university coursework (30 credits) prior to applying for admission.

Be aware, the number of applicants to Dental Hygiene often exceeds the total number of available spaces. Please note: It is <u>recommended that students have a second academic/career goal</u> in mind when choosing the elective course.

Program requirements are subject to change annually -

- Students must review up-to-date program information within each institution's calendar and Dental Hygiene website, to confirm the application process, course requirements, volunteer or paid experience, and any additional requirements needed, to be admitted
- Potential applicants should <u>note the **competitive** GPA recommended</u> at each institution to be considered for admission and note the minimum grade required may differ at each institution.
- Course transfers should be checked by using the online transfer guide at: www.bctransferguide.ca for BC applicants and for out of province applicants; sent to each institution by their stated deadlines

The following TRU courses are recommended for application

 6 credits of 1st year Chemistry (with labs) CHEM 1500 and CHEM 1510 or CHEM 1520 	CHEM 11 (or CHEM 0500) or Chem 12 (CHEM 0600); Pre- Calculus 12 (or Math 0600/0610); CHEM 1500 (C-) or CHEM 1500 (C-) and Chem 12 (or CHEM 0600) B grade recommended
4. 6 credits of 1st year Psychology PSYC 1110/1210	None
5. 3 credits of Statistics STAT 1200	Principles of Math 11 or MATH 0410/0510, C grade minimum
6. 3 credit Elective	Check each course you are considering for your electives to ensure you meet the pre-requisite(s) if any required.

In addition to the educational requirements, there are a number of general requirements that must be satisfied prior to applying for admission. Students should consult the appropriate institution(s) website and online calendar for this information.

Note: This is to be used as a guideline for students planning on transferring to Dental Hygiene programs. Due to changes that can occur at any post-secondary institution, it is the <u>student's responsibility</u> to check that courses selected meet the requirements of the institution(s) where they plan to complete the Dental Hygiene program.
