



The Faculty of Medicine at UBC offers a four-year medical education program leading to a Doctor of Medicine (MD). All students must meet the academic and other standards set by the Faculty of Medicine and will graduate with a UBC degree. **288** students are selected each cycle and will be distributed across the province within four training sites:

Students planning to apply for admission to the Doctor of Medicine program at UBC should select courses that satisfy the requirements of a Bachelor's degree of their choice along with the courses needed to qualify for admission. Consideration will be given to students from a variety of backgrounds, and no particular degree program is considered ideal for the study and practice of medicine. A variety of pre-medical academic backgrounds are considered desirable. As admission to UBC Medicine is extremely competitive, students should plan for an alternative career option.

A minimum of 90 university-transferable credits with grades taken at a post-secondary institution. (AP, IB and A Level credit do not count towards the 90 minimum credits).
