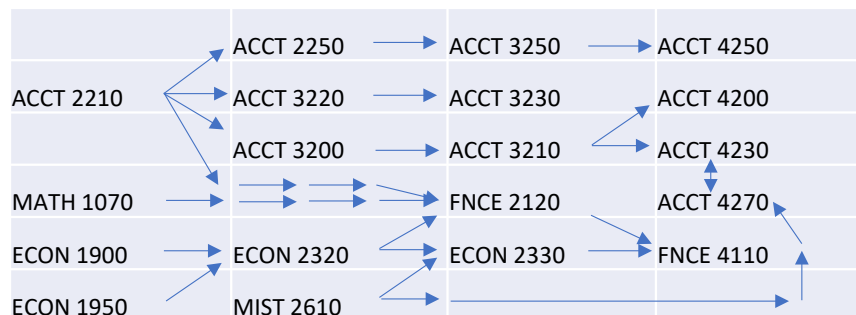


Key Course Sequence

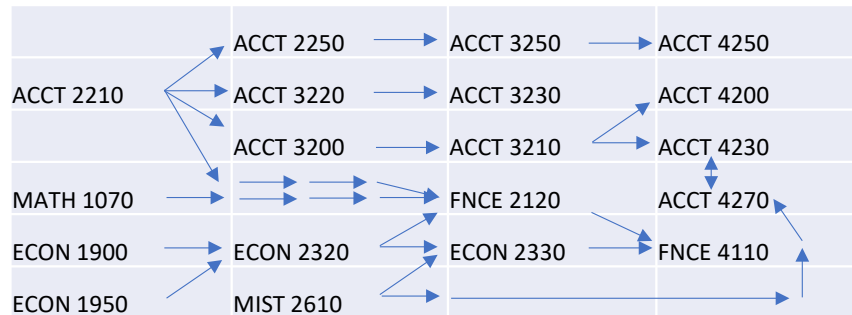
