

Language and Culture programs

During these lessons you will be assessed and assigned to a class that matches your language level. From there, you will typically start your days with either Language Studies or your elective of choice and then participate in one of our many exciting cultural activities!

Global Citizenship

Three-week Enhanced Language and Culture Transition program
