
Understanding Enrolment Dynamics: A Contextual Analysis & A Historical Overview

Enrolment Definitions

Headcount Enrolment

> 1 student = 1 headcount



Course Enrolment

Every course in which a student is enrolled 1 student =

1 or more course enrolments



Full Time Equivalent

FTE converts course enrolments to the number of students carrying a normal full credit load for the year (Ministry accountability)




Historical Course Enrolment - TRU

(Ministry of Post-Secondary Education and Future Skills)












Open Learning Domestic Students Origins





Open Learning Fiscal Year Headcount






FTEs by **Program Takers** is down slightly from last year, but **up 15%** from 2018/19

FTE Enrolment by Fiscal Year






FTEs by **Course Takers (undeclared)** is **down 23%** since 2018/19, mostly **domestic students**







Kamloops Campus % (Fall Term)








Domestic - International Proportions Based on Headcount

TRU Total % (Fiscal Year)




Fall Term Headcount – Kamloops Campus

Fall Term Headcount – Williams Lake Campus



International students




- India has remained at roughly the same proportion over the last 4 years, between 41% and 45%
- China has declined steadily over the past several years


Fall 2023

Historical Course Enrolment International Students, On Campus




On Campus Domestic Students Origins (2022/23)







Historical Fiscal Year Course Enrolment Domestic On Campus







Indigenous Headcount by Credential Type (TRU Overall)




High School Student Transitions







SD27 Transition Rates






Institutional Course Enrolment Projections
