With small class sizes, you receive personalized care. You also receive extra support through the ESL Language Learning Centre and the Writing Centre—everything from general conversational practice to personal assistance with classroom presentations or research papers.

As a beginner or advanced English learner, you strengthen your English language abilities and meet the requirements for admission to all TRU programs.
