Purpose:

The Strategic Internationalization Plan Advisory Committee (SIPAC) is responsible for overseeing the establishment of the Strategic Internationalization Plan at Thompson Rivers University (TRU). The purpose of this process is to create and prepare the Strategic Internationalization Plan for endorsement to the TRU governance bodies. The SIPAC advises the Vice-President International and the Special Advisor to the Vice-President International on matters related to the strategic internationalization planning.

Committee Functions and Responsibilities

- 1. Provide advice and guidance on the establishment and the development of the Strategic Internationalization Plan.
- 2. Work with member's unit to contribute to the institutional Strategic Internationalization Plan.
- 3. Participate in the SIPAC activities and workshops.
- 4. Provide opportunities and encourage dialogue among students, faculty, staff, and administration with respect to the Strategic Internationalization Plan.
- 5. Provide input on internal and external communication to keep the TRU community informed of and engaged in the Strategic Internationalization Planning process.
- 6. Establish subcommittees and working groups as needed to fulfil the SIPAC's responsibilities.
- 7. Other duties as assigned by the Vice-President International.
