Winter 2021 enrolment snapshot as of January 31, 2021

FYTD: April 1, 2020 to January 31, 2021

Headcount Enrolment

1 student = 1 headcount Course Enrolment

Every course in which a student is enrolled

1 student = 1 or more course enrolments Full Time Equivalent (FTE)

FTE converts course enrolments to the number of students carrying a normal full credit load for the year (Ministry accountability)

Indigenous (self-declared): 40 (22%)








