1. Climbing Gym Instructor Program

The goal of the Level 2 course is to certify instructors for teaching and coaching lead climbing courses and intermediate to advanced movement skills on artificial climbing walls.

Successful participants are well prepared and have a professional attitude. There is a precourse assignment that must be completed. During the course participants are required to demonstrate: personal climbing ability, knowledge of industry safety standards, and the ability to instruct climbing techniques.

2. Application Information

TO BECOME A LEVEL 2 INSTRUCTOR

- You must have a Level 1 Climbing Gym Instructor Certificate
- □ You flash 5.10+ on artificial structures or rock
- □ Have assisted on several lead climbing courses
- □ Have 30 hours of instruction (as a level 1 instructor)

TO APPLY YOU MUST SUBMIT

- **u** Updated climbing resume, see sample format below
- □ Letter of recommendation from a facility operator, CGI level 3 Instructor or ACMG Guide which confirms your personal climbing and instructional experience as noted above.
- □ Proof of standard (16 hr.) first aid certification (send a photocopy of certificate)
- Other information you feel is pertinent

CONCERNING APPLICATIONS

It is strongly recommended that you allow yourself adequate time to create a well-structured, organized, and complete application that arrives on time. Keep in mind that your application is a first impression. As such it plays a significant role in whether you will be accepted into the program or not. Poorly organized applications or unformatted resumes jeopardize your acceptance as your background, skills and qualifications may not be clear and/or may compare unfavourably to other applications. Please retain a copy of your application for your records or in case of loss.

APPLICATION DEADLINE

Applications must be complete and received by the CMSG Program office by the application closing date. Late or incomplete applications may not be accepted.

Dates and fees are updated regularly and may change without notice. Applications must be delivered via e-mail. They should be saved in a .pdf package and e-mailed to <u>cmsg@tru.ca</u>. They should only be faxed if you don't have any other options.

Applicants will be notified of acceptance into the course, once accepted the course fee is due and must be paid in full to confirm placement. Please see payment details below.
