Program Description

The Health Care Assistant program offers the BC Provincial HCA Curriculum, is 27 weeks or 745 hours in length and consists of courses in the basic concepts of health, client centered care, personal care and assistance, common health challenges and cognitive challenges as they are applied to the care of older individuals and their families. Studies will give students the technical knowledge, human understanding and practical skills to provide responsible and competent client-centered care. Graduates of the program will be prepared to function as Health Care Assistants and team members in residential care facilities and home care agencies. Admission Requirements

- Completion of Grade 11 (Grade 12 preferred) or Mature Student Status (or equivalent)
- English 11 with a minimum 73% (or equivalent)
- Canadian Citizenship or Permanent Residency

All HCA applicants are required to demonstrate English Language Proficiency. Applicants not having met grade 11/12 English may do so by submitting a successful Accuplacer Result. Contact the Assessment Centre at 250-828-5470 or email <u>assess@tru.ca</u> to book a testing date.

Applicants whose first language is <u>not English</u> are required to demonstrate English Language Proficiency with evidence of test scores from one of the following requirements; (TOEFL) Test of English as a Foreign Language, (IELTS) International English Language Testing System, (CLB PT) Canadian Language Benchmark Placement Test, (CELPIP) Canadian English Language Proficiency Index or (CAEL) Canadian Academic English Language Assessment. Accepted Students Program Requirements

Consent to a Criminal Record Check – admitted students are required to submit a completed criminal record check.

HSPnet Form – Consent form for the Use and Disclosure of Student Information.

Student Immunization Record – All HCA students visiting clinical placements are considered health care providers and should be protected against vaccine preventable diseases.
