## Program Admission Process

The BScN program follows a selective admission process; students with the minimum admission requirements will be considered but are not guaranteed admission to the program. When selecting students for the BScN program, the Selective Admissions Committee considers: (A) satisfactory completion of all required admission courses; (B) academic background and performance; and (C) letter of introduction.

Grade 12</b> or equivalent or mature student status</li> <li>• <b>B.C. English 12 or English 12 First Peoples</b> with a minimum of 73% (with the government exam within the last 5 years); or level (5) on the composition section of the Language Proficiency Index (LPI), with all other categories of the LPI at a minimum of 70% (within the last 2 years); or LPI level (4) if completed between October 1, 2012 and October 1, 2013; or satisfactory completion of TRU English Assessment (ACCUPLACER) test at university entrance level; or completion of TRU ENGL 0600 (B) minimum grade or completion of ESAL 0570 &amp; ESAL 0580 with a (C+) minimum grade</li> <li>• <b>B.C. Foundations Math 12</b> (preferred) or Pre-Calculus 12, or TRU MATH 0600 and 0610, or equivalent with a C+ minimum grade. (BC Principles of Math 11 with a C minimum will be accepted if completed between 2004 and August 31, 2012)</li> <li>• <b>B.C. Biology 12</b> or TRU BIOL 0600, or equivalent with C+ minimum grade</li> <li>• <b>B.C. Chemistry 11</b> or TRU CHEM 0500, or equivalent C+ minimum grade</li> <li>• <b>One other Science at the Grade 11 or 12 level</b> or TRU BIOL 0500, 0620, or CHEM 0600, or PHYS 0500 or 0600, or COMP 0500 or 0600 or 0650, or SINC 0500, or equivalent with a C+ minimum grade. University level students also have the option of choosing from: BIOL 1040 or 1050 or 1110 or 1210, CHEM 1500, COMP 1130, GEOG 1000 or 2020, GEOL 1110, PHYS 1100 or 1150.</li> </ul> <p><b>Note:</b> If BIOL 1590/1690 are both completed at the application deadline the grade 11/12 Science requirements may be waived. If only BIOL 1590 is completed it can be used in lieu of BIOL 12 or the other Science 11 or 12.</p>
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**High School students** can apply during their grade 12 year but must submit an Official Grade 11 Transcript as well as a Certified Interim Grade 12 Transcript with proof of courses in progress with their application. Final transcripts must also be submitted upon course completion.

**Post-Secondary/Mature students** must provide evidence of registration for Admission Requirement course(s) by the application deadline date. Applicants must submit an Official Transcript(s) upon applying showing course(s) In-Progress, then Official/Certified Interim Grades. Post-Secondary courses must be completed by April 30<sup>th</sup> and a final Official Transcript must be submitted upon completion.
