

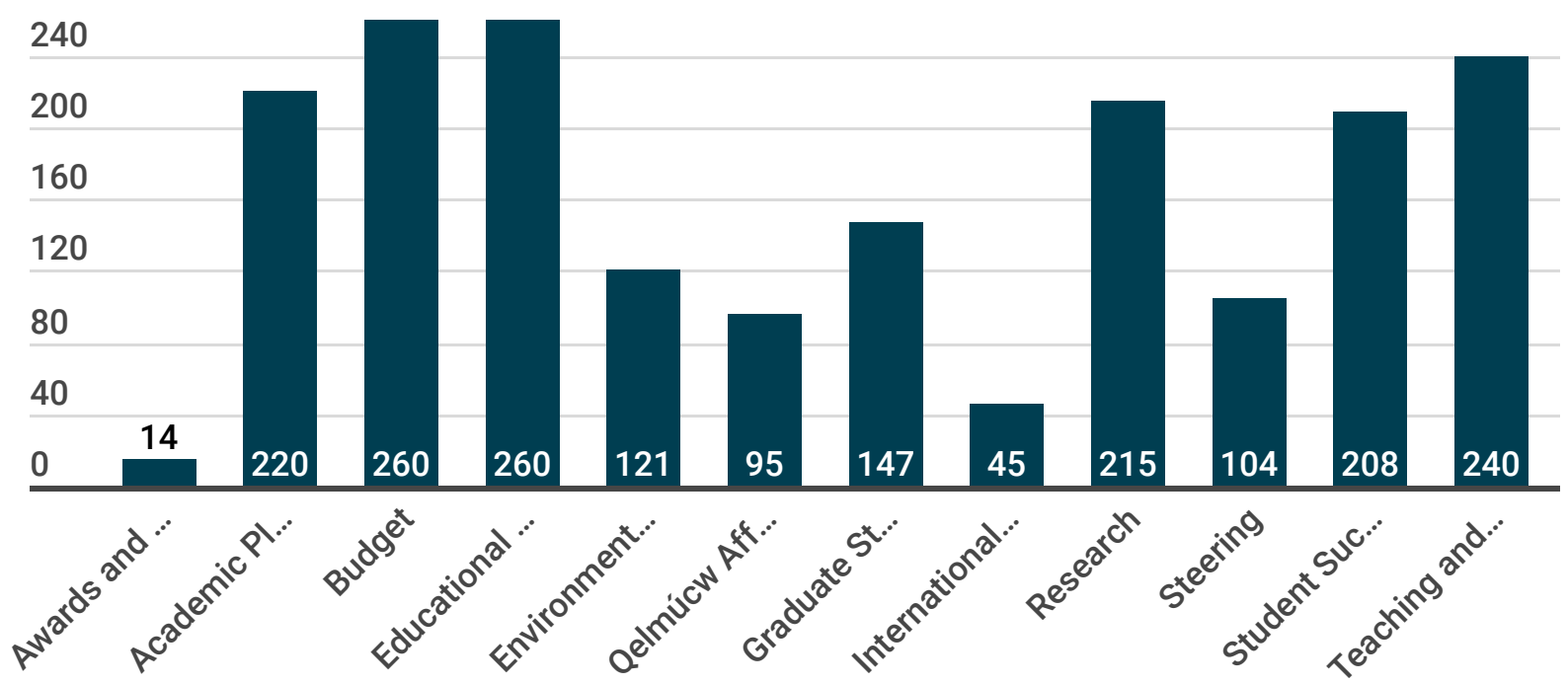


Standing Senate Committees

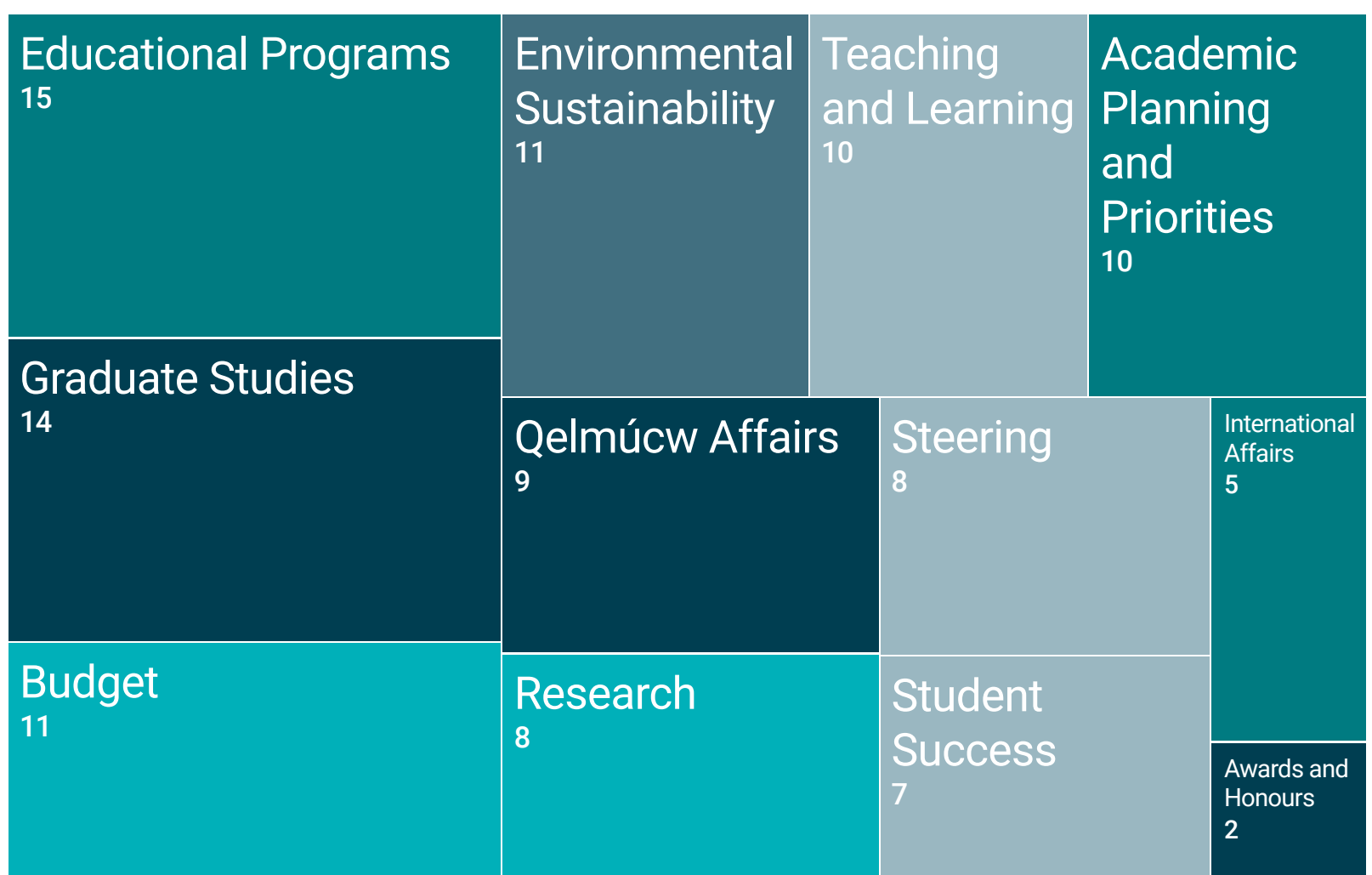
The Senate currently has 12 standing committees. Each of these committees has its own terms of reference and meeting schedule, which require these committees to meet with varying frequency.

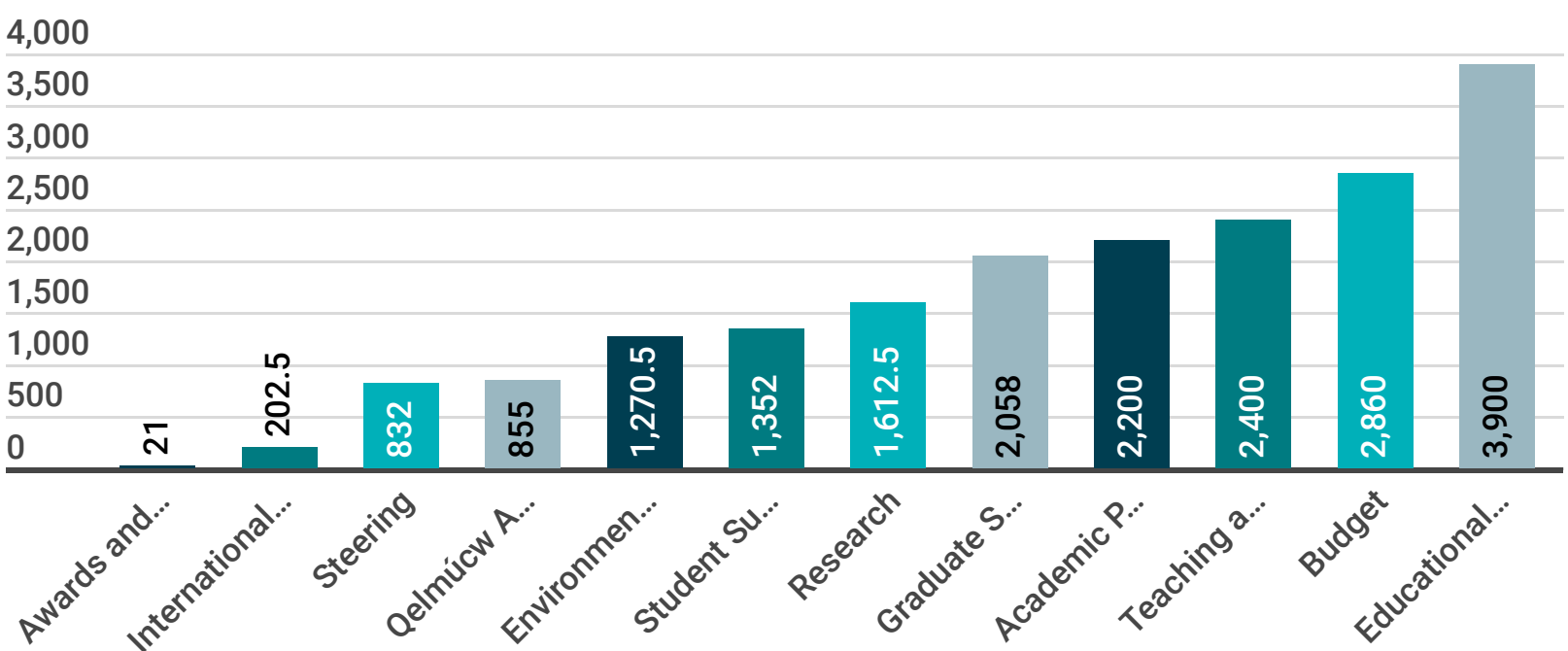
In the 2018/19 academic year, there were 84 committee meetings at which committee members attended 1,574 times
