It needs to be dense with information but also well-written, well-organized and self-contained, without references, abbreviations, acronyms, jargon, figures or tables. **Abstracts may not exceed one page or 150 words.** 

Keywords: Include a list of up to eight keywords two lines below the last line of text in the abstract. Choice of these keywords is very important, as they will be used for the electronic indexing of your thesis.
