

What Courses Do I Take?

1. MATHEMATICS:

If you took Pre-Calculus 12 (C+), choose MATH 1070 & MATH 1170

If you took Foundations of MATH 12 (C+), choose MATH 1070 & MATH 1170

UPGRADING OPTIONS:

If you took Pre-Calculus 12 (C grade), choose TRU's MATH 1000 & MATH 1070

If you took Foundations MATH 12 (C grade), choose MATH 0650 & MATH 1070 OR MATH 0510, MATH 0600, & MATH 1070

2. ENGLISH:

If you took English 12/First Peoples 12 73% (gov't included) or equivalent, choose ENGL1100

If you took English 12/First Peoples 12 80% (gov't included) or equivalent, Engl 1100 or 1110 or 1120 or 1140 or 1210

If you took English 12/First Peoples 12 below 73%, write Accuplacer or take Engl 0600 **and** Engl 1100
