The University Librarian is responsible to the Provost and Vice-President Academic for providing visionary leadership in creating a learner-centred library environment, directing the Library's contribution to the teaching and research goals of TRU's programs, and ensuring the TRU community has access to quality resources, services, technologies and professionals in alignment with the mission and vision of TRU.

The successful candidate will be an empathetic, collegial leader who brings a strong commitment to academic librarianship, possesses academic leadership and administrative experience, and has demonstrable knowledge of trends and current issues in academic libraries. They will require exceptional communication and interpersonal skills and have respect for and be a champion of equity, diversity and inclusion. They will be able to operate strategically, have a record of professional excellence, scholarly engagement and service to the profession, with a strong appreciation for the intellectual and operational diversity across the spectrum of disciplines within TRU. The position is for a 5-year term, which is renewable. A MLIS/MLS from an American Library Association accredited program (or equivalent) is required.

- Fostering excellence in teaching and research
